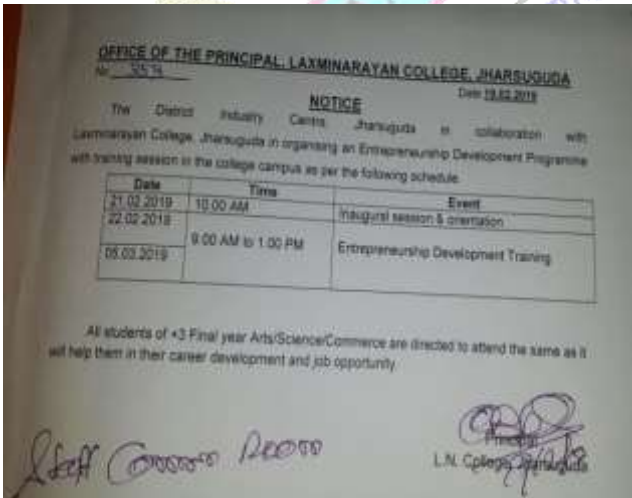
Entrepreneurship Development Program by District Industry Center

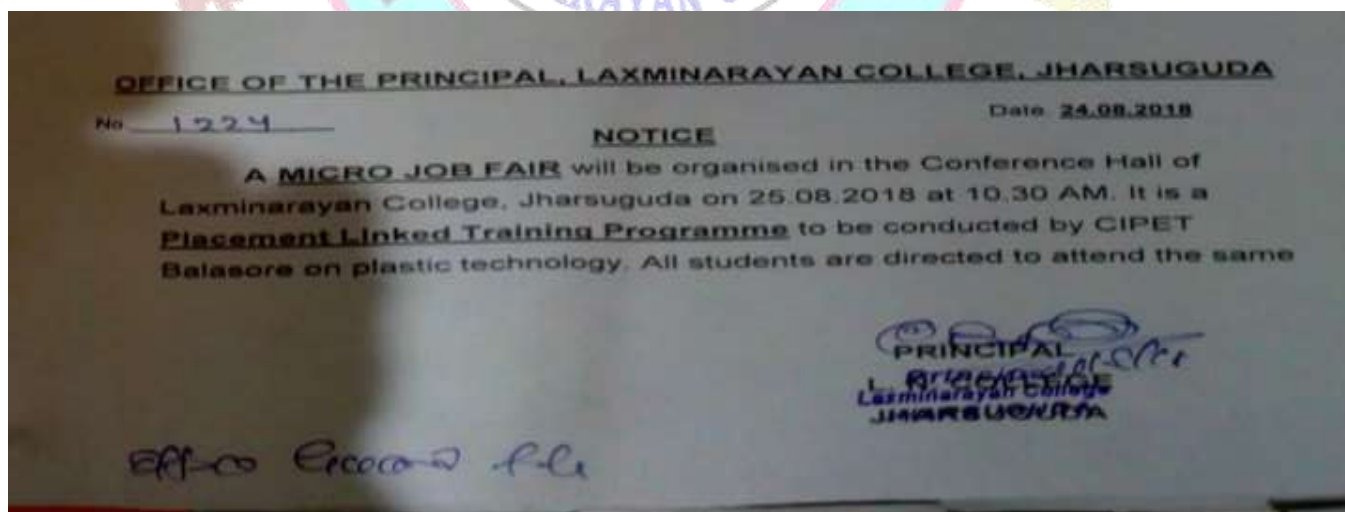
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MICRO JOB FAIR

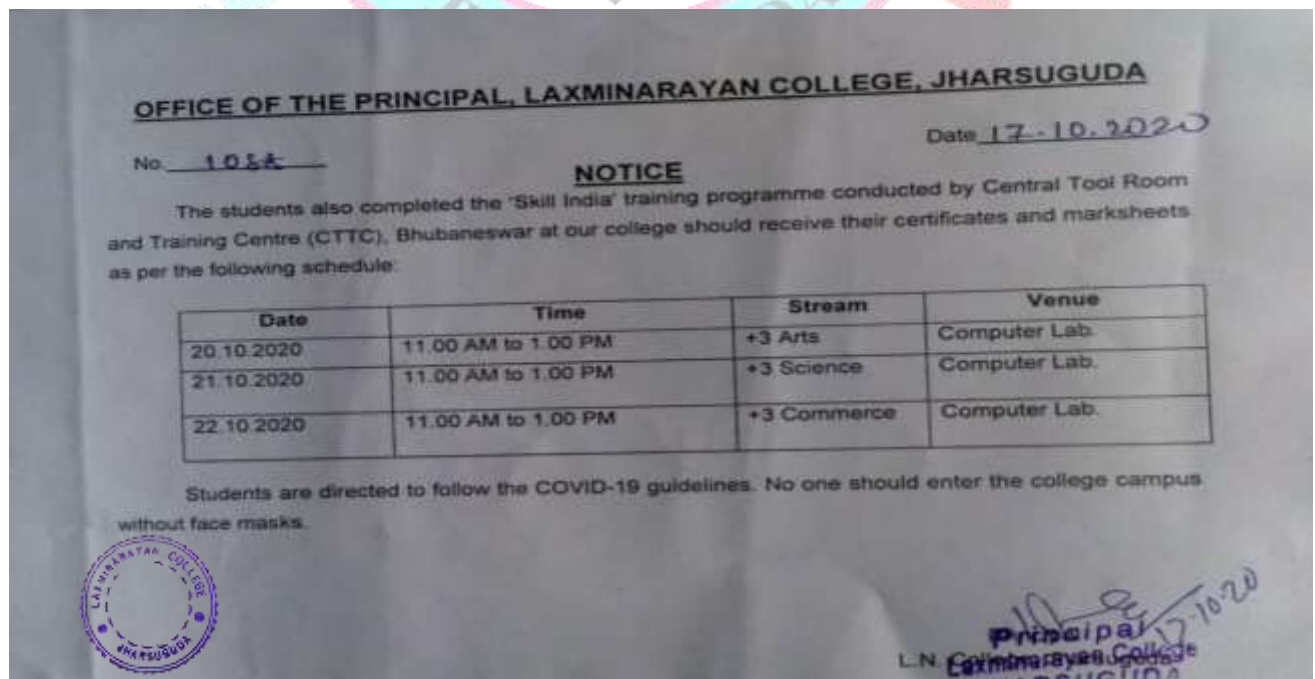
Youth Workshop

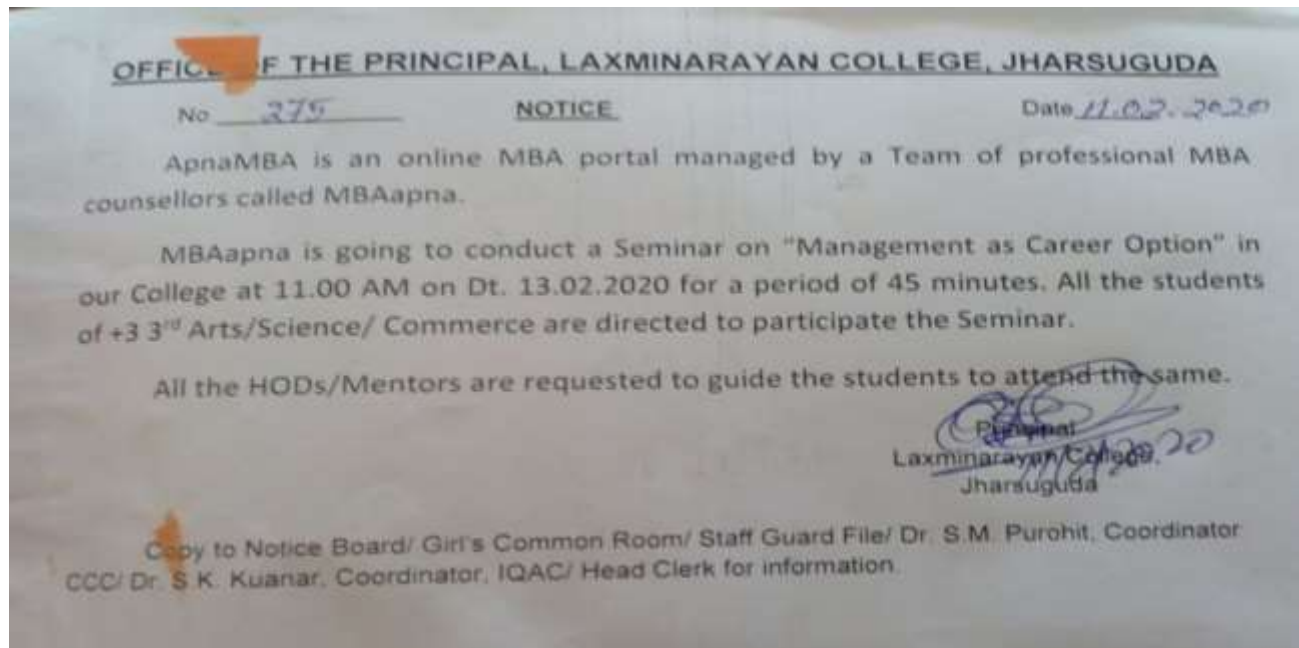
Skill Development Training Program by Central Tool Room & Training Centre (CTTC), Bhubaneswar

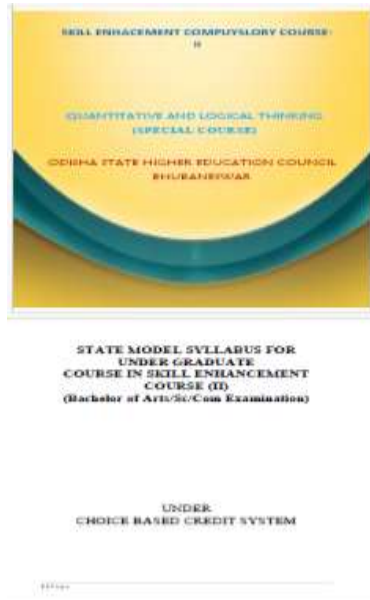
