## 1. Clean Up Drive in the Surrounding Areas of College Campus by Students

A Clean Up Drive in the surrounding areas of college campus by students in collaboration with National Service Scheme (NSS) and Eco Club was held on 20. 02.2018. The program was guided by the NSS coordinator and the members of The Eco Club. The drive focuses on removing litter, clearing pathways, and promoting proper waste disposal practices among residents.

## 2. Plantation Program by NSS and YRC outside the Campus

A plantation program was conducted on 07. 12. 20 by the National Service Scheme and Youth Red Cross unit in collaboration with the municipality. More than 80 volunteers of NSS and YRC, students and faculty members participated in planting trees in unused open spaces, and roadside areas to enhance green cover and improve air quality. Around 50 numbers of saplings of indigenous varieties were planted on this occasion.

### **3. Plantation Program in nearby village by NSS, YRC and NCC**

As part of the Green Initiative Program of the institution, a plantation program was organized in Purna village by the National Service Scheme (NSS), Youth Red Cross (YRC), and NCC in collaboration with Sambad Sahitya Ghara on 19.11.2021. This event aimed at enhancing the green cover in the village and promoting environmental awareness among the local community. Students, faculty members, and local residents actively participated in the program. Over 100 volunteers from NSS, YRC, and NCC took part in the drive, planting 50 saplings across various locations in the village. The event focused on planting a variety of indigenous trees around the village. Alongside the plantation, an awareness campaign was conducted, educating participants and onlookers about the importance of trees in combating climate change, reducing pollution, and supporting biodiversity.

#### **4. Water Conservation Awareness Program and Cleaning of Pond in Dalki village by College Students**

The college launched a water conservation drive in nearby Dalki village on 02.022022; focusing on educating villagers about water-saving techniques. This effort aimed to restore local water bodies, raise awareness about the importance of water conservation, and promote sustainable practices within the community. As part of this initiative, NSS volunteers, students and local villagers also actively participated in cleaning and restoring a major local pond, which is crucial for water supply of the community and biodiversity. In addition to the cleaning efforts, educational sessions were held to inform villagers about simple and effective water conservation practices. Topics included rainwater harvesting, reducing water wastage, and protecting local water resources.
