

"Mo College Abhijan" has been implemented in the college for providing a platform to enable willing alumni of L.N College, Jharsuguda contribute towards development of the alma mater. As per the instruction from MCAPS of Govt. of Odisha, a new Bank Account has been opened for Alumni contribution. The college has an active Alumni Association and its alumni are spread across the globe. The CLC is putting on concerted effort to connect to the alumni and rope them in for the development of the institution.

As per the direction of MCAPS, a new bank account has been opened for MCAPS funds. Alumni of the college have been coming forward in large numbers to register in the Mo College Abhijan portal and contribute to MCAPS funds of the college. At the same time, various interactive activities too are conducted bringing the alumni and U.G. students together.

Objectives of Mo College Abhijan:

- 1. To connect the alumni with the Alma Mater for the betterment of the college eco-system.
- 2. To invite the alumni to the college to interact with the students, faculty and staff and share their life lessons, success stories and experience in order to inspire and motivate others.

- 3. To provide a platform to the alumni to offer voluntary service for the all-round development of the college eco-system. For example, a doctor may be invited to conduct a health camp; an NGO representative may take the students to its operational area and make them aware of ground realities; a technocrat may be contacted to take the students to visit the industrial area etc.
- To receive donations, if any, in the form of cash/cheque/electronic transfer or in the shape of material from the alumni and utilize the same for the development of the college.
- Similar voluntary services/donations may be availed from non-alumni philanthropists, Charitable organizations, group of persons, institutions etc.
- To conduct and organize activities like Knowledge Sharing, Sports Events, Cultural Events, Social Projects, Career Counselling and Placement Assistance etc. for the students by involving the alumni.

Programme under Mo College Abhijan

- As CLC (College Level Committee) was formed to monitor and execute various projects from time to time as executive body in the college where Governing Body of MCAPS under HED is the Apex Body and a joint account was opened in HDFC Bank to receive funds for implementation of the projects.
- 2. As per letter No. 212/ MCAPS/2021 dated 23.09.2021 the college received the 1st Matching Grant for the project "Repair and Renovation of Conference Hall" for the amount of Rs.200000.00 against the project cost of Rs.300000.00 becoming one of the among institutes of Odisha receiving the grant for the first time.
- As per Letter No 1349 dated 07.08.2023 Utilisation Certificate for the "Repair and Renovation of Conference Hall" was submitted.
- 4. As per letter no 734/MCAPS/2023 Dated 21.11.23 Dr Hrushikesh Mohanty, College Coordinator MCAPS visited the college on 27.09.2023 to inspect developmental project namely "Repair and renovation of conference hall" and reported that repair and renovation of conference hall have been completed. However, major portion of the interior room ceiling work has been collapsed due to leaking roof and water seepage. Subsequently, detail fact about the execution of the project and proposal to complete the project work once again within one month by repairing the damaged part with the college development fund was decided.
- As per letter no. 933/LNC, dated 03.05.2024 a completion letter was submitted to CEO, Mo College regarding reconstruction of damaged part of the project under Mo College of L.N College Jharsuguda that is "Repair and Renovation of Conference hall."
- 6. Our college organised under Mo College banner various events.
