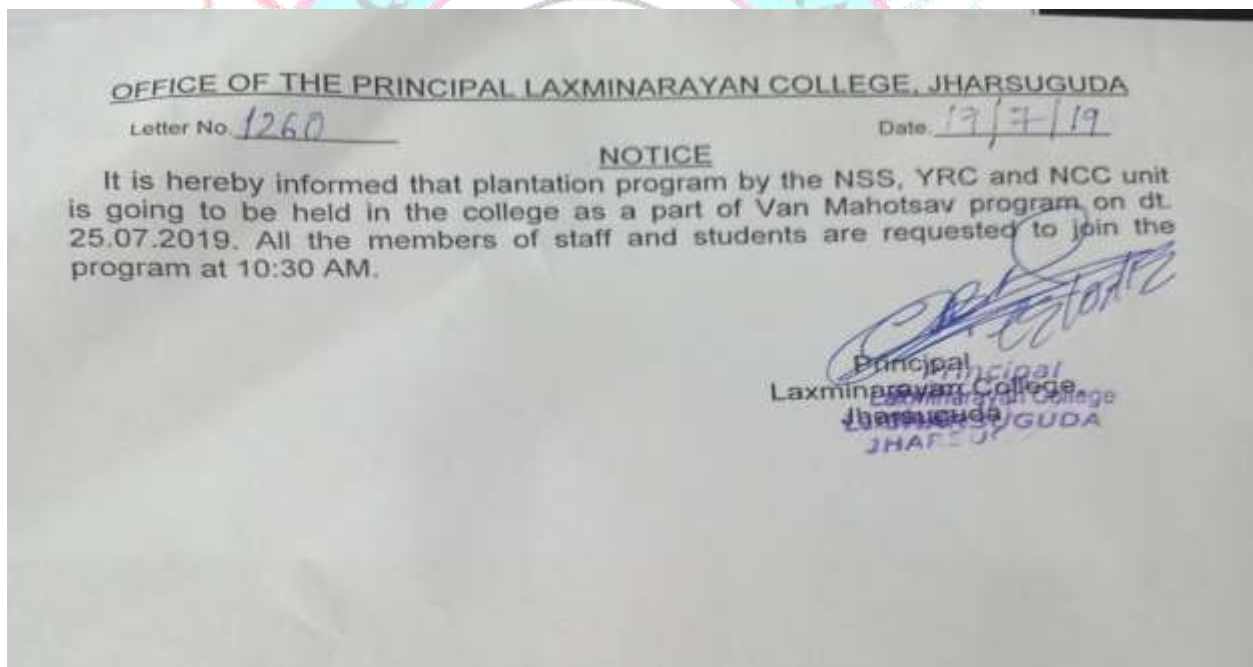

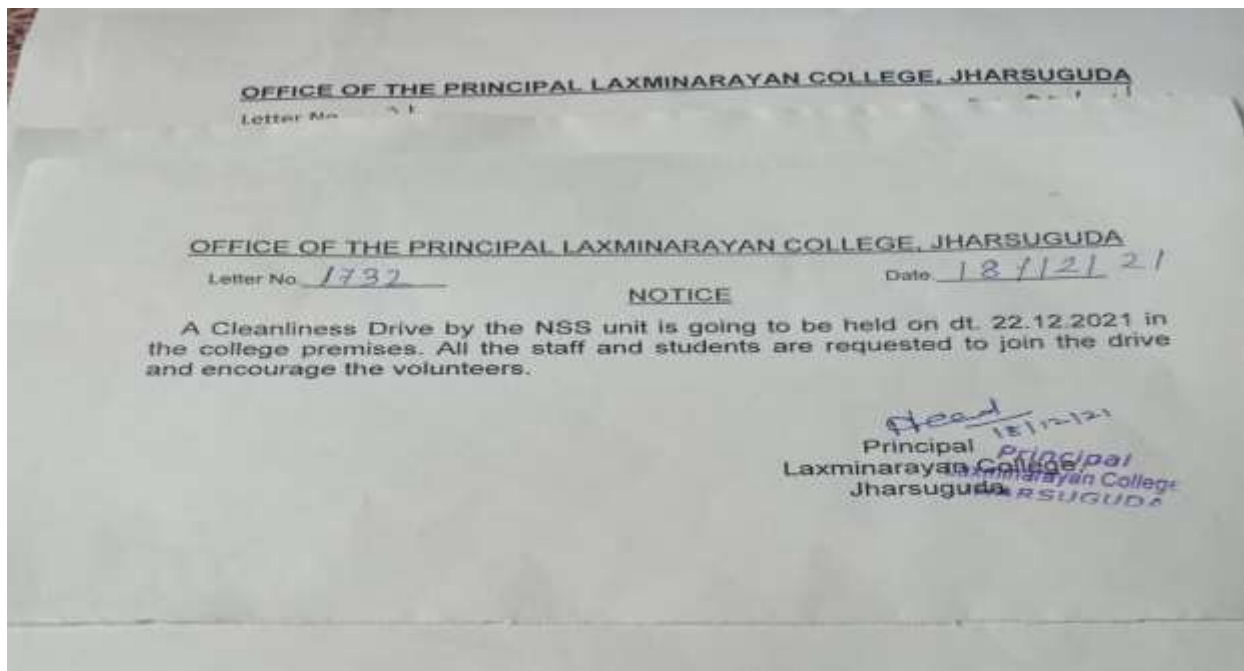

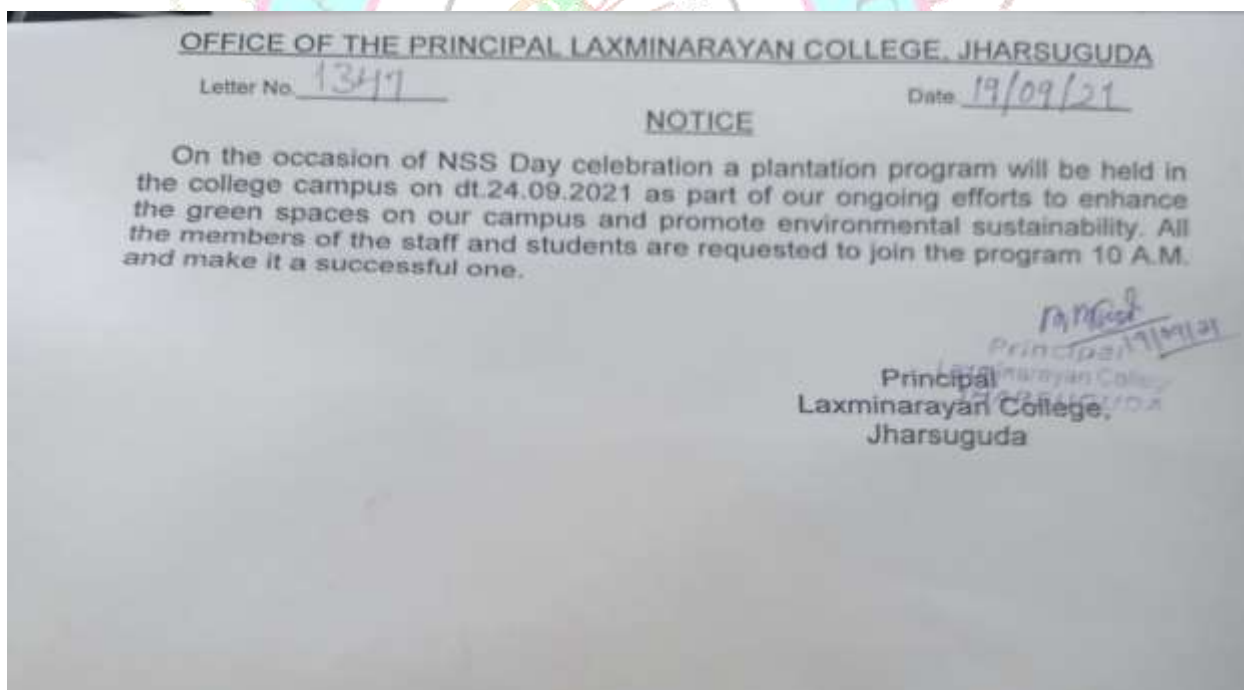

Key points of the policy are as follows:

- The use of single-use plastic items is strictly prohibited within all college buildings, grounds, events, and activities. This includes classrooms, offices, cafeterias, and outdoor areas.
- Environmental friendly alternatives such as reusable bags, bottles, containers, and biodegradable or compostable alternatives to plastic products are encouraged and should be utilized wherever pos
- Educational campaigns and awareness programs will be conducted to inform students, faculty, and staff about the environmental impact of single-use plastic and the importance of reducing plastic consumption.
