National Commission for Women (NCW) has adopted a nice step to initiate a training for the capacity building of female students through Personality Development Programme.

Objective of the Workshop

This Workshop on 'CAPACITY BUILDING & PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT' will focus on preparing girl students for entering job/employment market. Sometimes because of lack of confidence an individual may not be able to demonstrate good professional and communication skills. The course will focus on learning and applying the use of intuitive, logical and critical thinking, communication and interpersonal skills, not limited to cognitive/creative skills. These skills and behavior set, when learned, will enhance outcome of employability.

Target Group:

Under-Graduate Female Students

Training session:

There will be one-day training with multiple sessions for capacity building and Personality Development.

Evaluation of the Participants:

In order to make the training effective, it is important that the students actually remember the information taught to them. After completion of all three sessions students will be asked to take the quiz provided by NCW. The participants will be tested for their understanding of the subject through MCQs. The question paper will be based on the booklet/ training sessions conducted under the program. The participants will have to answer 20 Multiple-Choice Questions prepared by NCW within a time frame of 30 minutes. Each correct answer will be awarded two marks. There will be no negative marking. 10 best performers will be awarded with the Certificate of Excellence.

Certification:

All the participants will be awarded a Certificate of Participation on completing the quiz. 10 best performers will be awarded with the Certificate of Excellence.
