The history of **National Cadet Corps (NCC)** can be found before independence of our country, and at that time it was termed as "**University Corps**". The word NCC came into existence on 16th July1948 under the NCC Act XXXVI of 1948 under the Ministry of Defence. Moreover, NCC is also known as 2nd line of defence of our country. It consists of three wings namely Army wing, Air wing and Naval wing.

The motto of NCC is "**Unity and Discipline**" and it aims to develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, spirit of adventure and sportsmanship and ideals of selfless service among the youth. It aims to create a human resource of organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all walks of life and always be available for the service of the nation. It also aims to provide a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

The AIR wing NCC of Laxminarayan college Jharsuguda comes to existence from 2021 with a total seat of 50 cadets at a time. It is functioning under 2 (O) AIR SQN (FLG) NCC unit, which comes under Sambalpur group head quarter.

Enrolled cadets are given institutional training and classes are conducted by ANO, CO and different PI staffs of the unit. Moreover, parade classes are conducted weekly in the college premises. The cadets participate in different camps such as Annual Training Camp, Combined Annual Training Camp, Attachment Camp, Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Camp, Mountaineering Camp, Attachment Camp, All India Vayu Sainik Camp, Republic Day Camp, etc.

By following the aims of NCC, Cadets have shown their selflessness by actively participating in different social service activities such as Blood Donation, tree planting, campus cleaning, Assisting Physically challenged and old persons during the election, community works and different awareness programmes.
